REQUIRED Supplies:

Please have your supplies by the first class meeting: April 2nd!

STRATHMORE 400 Drawing paper pad (18" x 24")

1 SKETCH Paper Pad, 18" x 24", Strathmore 300 or equivalent

Tracing paper - roll or pad AT LEAST 18" x 24" www.dickblick.com

Drawing board with clips large enough to hold your 18" x 24" paper

Mechanical Pencil (any brand - 0.7 lead)

Wooden pencils: 2B

T-Square 24"

Ruler 18" - metal

1 Plastic Drafting Triangle: 45/45/90 (STAPLES) - 10" or 12"

1 roll 3/4" white artist's tape (preferred) (or removable drafting tape)

1 gray kneaded eraser

1 white plastic eraser

1 pencil sharpener (metal is recommended)

Portfolio to hold your drawings (in your price range)

OPTIONAL SUPPLIES:

Small tool box to hold your art supplies

Soft brush to remove eraser debris from your drawings easily
