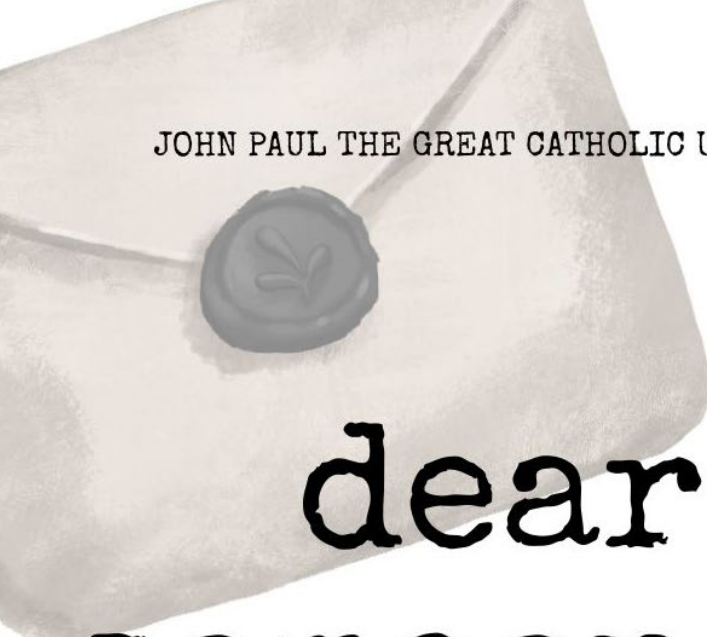

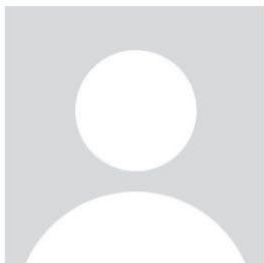

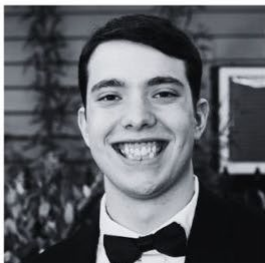
Luke Bennett is a silhouette who haunts the university offices, occasionally creating EDM and orchestral music.
