eLearning Setup and Writing Proficiency Exam

Mandatory For: All New students

The faculty of JPCatholic believes that all of our students must elevate their ability to write clear, correct and compelling English to a level higher than that required simply to gain admission to the university. This strong writing ability will serve students throughout their lives.

So that we can assess the current level of writing ability of incoming students, we administer a Writing Proficiency Exam soon after students arrive. The results of this exam allow us to identify which students will take our freshman-level College Writing 1 course and which students may skip this course and take on more advanced instruction.

Please Note:

- Even if you have already taken the Writing Proficiency Exam in advance, you must still attend this meeting in order to receive instructions on setting up your eLearning account on Moodle. You do not need to stay for the exam.
- All students must bring their laptop.
- No other preparation is needed.
- Please arrive 10 minutes early to check-in.

Writing Proficiency Requirement (jpcatholic.com/catalog)

All students are required to take a writing proficiency exam when they begin their studies at JPCatholic. Students entering in the fall quarter will take the exam during orientation or the first weeks of the fall quarter. Students entering in other quarters will work with the Registrar to schedule a time for the writing proficiency exam. All students are required to pass the writing proficiency exam before they will be allowed to register for classes in their junior year. Students who do not pass the writing proficiency exam when they enter will be required to take HUMA122 College Writing I. As part of this course, students will retake the writing proficiency exam. Any student who does not pass HUMA122 College Writing I will be required to retake it. Any student who does not pass the writing proficiency exam after taking HUMA122 College Writing I will be required to work with the Writing Center and their advisor to pass the writing proficiency exam.
